- Visit a zoo

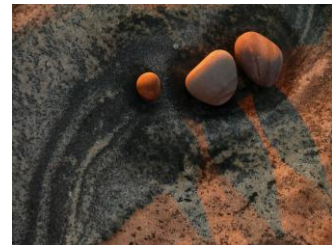


- Take an object
